

Southern New Hampshire Regional Water Project – Pressure Reducing Valve Stations
Bi-Weekly Progress Report
February 5, 2020

This report identifies work on the Pressure Reducing Valve (PRV) Stations Project that Northeast Earth Mechanics, Inc. has completed in the last two weeks and anticipates progressing during the next two weeks. Project work will take place adjacent to, but off the roadway at two sites along Route 28. Travel on Rockingham Road (NH Route 28) should not be impacted during construction. Thank you for your patience during construction.

Last Two Weeks

- Northland Road Site:
 - Roof installation has begun. Electrical conduits have been installed and exterior piping and plumbing work has continued.
- Rail Trail Site:
 - Roof installation has begun. Installation of DI pipe and other exterior piping has begun.

- Roof installation will continue at both the Northland Road and Rail Trail sites. Installation of exterior piping and electrical conduits will continue at Northland Road. Installation of DI pipe and exterior piping will continue at Rail Trail. The meter pit at the Northland Road site is scheduled for installation. Material deliveries to both sites will continue.
