NH Route 28 Water Main Projects Southern NH Regional Water Projects S1A and S1B

October 21, 2019

As part of the Southern New Hampshire Regional Water (SNHRW) Project, the Town of Salem is expanding public water systems along Rockingham Road (NH Route 28) in the towns of Windham and Salem (see interactive project map: <https://www.townofsaalemnh.org/engineering-projects/pages/nh-route-28-water-main-projects>). Revoli Construction Co., Inc. was awarded both Contracts S1A and S1B and activities for both will run concurrently. Whenever possible, administrative tasks and project communications for these Contracts will be combined.

Project layout and initial construction efforts have started for Contract S1A and water main installation is expected to commence soon. Work will begin at the Derry/Windham town line and progress southward. The project is anticipated to be substantially completed in June of 2020. Travel on Rockingham Road (NH Route 28) and intersecting roadways will be impacted at times due to lane closures, lane shifts, and alternating one-way travel, and travel delays should be anticipated.

The objective of the SNHRW Project is to address elevated levels of methyl tertiary butyl ether (MtBE), which have been found to exceed the existing groundwater quality standard within areas of the southern tier of New Hampshire. The project is being funded by the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) through the MtBE Remediation Bureau and the Drinking Water and Groundwater Trust Fund (DWGTF).
