**Resolution #2024-36**

**Ratify and Affirm Vote of January 16, 2024 to Authorize Bonds/Notes**

**WHEREAS:** Town Council held a public hearing at its January 16, 2024 meeting in accordance with RSA 33:8-a,1 and RSA 33:8-d,1(b) as required by State Statute and Section 3.6.4 of the Town Charter to consider the issuance of bonds and notes; and

**WHEREAS:** At its January 16, 2024 meeting, the Town Council voted 9-0 in the affirmative to authorize the issuance of a \$38,600,000 bond for the construction of a new police station, a \$2,200,000 bond for the rehabilitation of the Millville Dam, and a \$100,000 Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Loan (collectively, the "Bonds"); and

**WHEREAS:** The January 16, 2024 public hearing and meeting were duly noticed by publication in the New Hampshire Union Leader on January 9, 2024 and by posting at the Town Hall, the Kelley Library and on the Town website on January 5, 2024; and

**WHEREAS:** At the Town Meeting and Ballot Vote held on Tuesday, March 12, 2024, the Bonds passed by a 3/5 majority as required.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SALEM TOWN COUNCIL THAT:**

The Salem Town Council hereby ratifies and affirms by roll call its vote of Monday, January 16, 2024 to authorize the issuance of the Bonds in accordance with the provisions of Charter Section 3.6.4 and RSA 33:8-a,1 and 33:8-d,1(b). This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage.


