Liberty Utilities Rail Trail Donation

WHEREAS: Liberty Utilities owns a power station at 3 Middle Street, otherwise known as Map 89, Lot 10115, which abuts the Rail Trail.

WHEREAS: The Town of Salem owns 80 Main Street, otherwise known as Map 89, Lot 1097, which abuts Liberty's property on the north side.

WHEREAS: The Town of Salem has submitted a temporary use permit to begin improvements along the northerly portion of Phase IV of the Rail Trail in advance of the full construction.

WHEREAS: The Municipal Services Department are the stewards thereof and work collectively with local organizations and abutting properties, for such purposes that enhance the recreational value of the facility.

WHEREAS: Liberty Utilities wishes to make a donation towards the cost to create natural screening of the power station and overall landscape improvements within the respective property bounds

WHEREAS: RSA 31:95-b authorizes the governing body to accept unanticipated funds made available during the year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SALEM TOWN COUNCIL THAT:
The Salem Town Council hereby accepts with gratitude a donation from Liberty Utilities in the amount of \$4,110.00 to be used for natural screening of the power station and overall landscape improvements within the respective property bounds.


