**Accept \$76,090 Grant from US Department of Energy for  
the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant**

**WHEREAS:** The Town Council received a grant from the US Department of Energy (USDOE) under the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) in the amount of \$76,090; and,

**WHEREAS:** The Town intends to use the EECBG funds for the installation of LED lighting and automatically dimming sensors at various municipal buildings per the application submitted to USDOE in April 2024; and,

**WHEREAS:** RSA 31:95-B authorizes the Town Council to accept such financial grants when they become available during the year.

The Salem Town Council hereby accepts with gratitude a grant in the amount of \$76,090.00 from the USDOE for the EECBG program.




