## Outdoor Activities

Pickleball: A fast growing paddle sport that combines elements of tennis, badminton and ping pong while played on a court smaller than a tennis court. Play is at the town tennis courts on Lawrence Road, next to Mary Queen of Peace Church. Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9am - 12pm (summer hours 8-11am). Starts in April.



Tennis: Play mixed doubles at the town courts on Lawrence Road, next to Mary Queen of Peace Church. Fun, non-competitive, for anyone with some level of experience (no lessons given). Tuesday and Thursday, 8-10am (mid June 7:30-10am).
