



# Salem Depot Master Plan

# Project Process

- Performed site walk with Depot Village Advisory Committee (DVAC)
- Met with DVAC to establish potential project program elements
- Prepared three alternative plans demonstrating various alternatives
- Revised two plans incorporating DVAC, staff and public comment
- Prepared a preferred alternative based on further input from DVAC
- Developed phasing plan and project renderings and presented the final plan to DVAC
- DVAC voted to recommend adoption of the plan.

# Guiding Principles

- Maintain the existing Veteran's Plaza design, with the area to the east of the plaza maintained as a passive space.
- Maintain the area in front of the existing Depot building as a passive area in deference to the historic nature of the building. Protect existing uses in the Depot building.
- Create a hub of activity related to the rail trail, improve access to the rail trail.
- Execute a land swap with Liberty Utilities to create shared access to the existing sub-station and provide more useable land for the park area.
- Create a visually coherent gateway along the Broadway and Main Street frontages.

# Depot Building



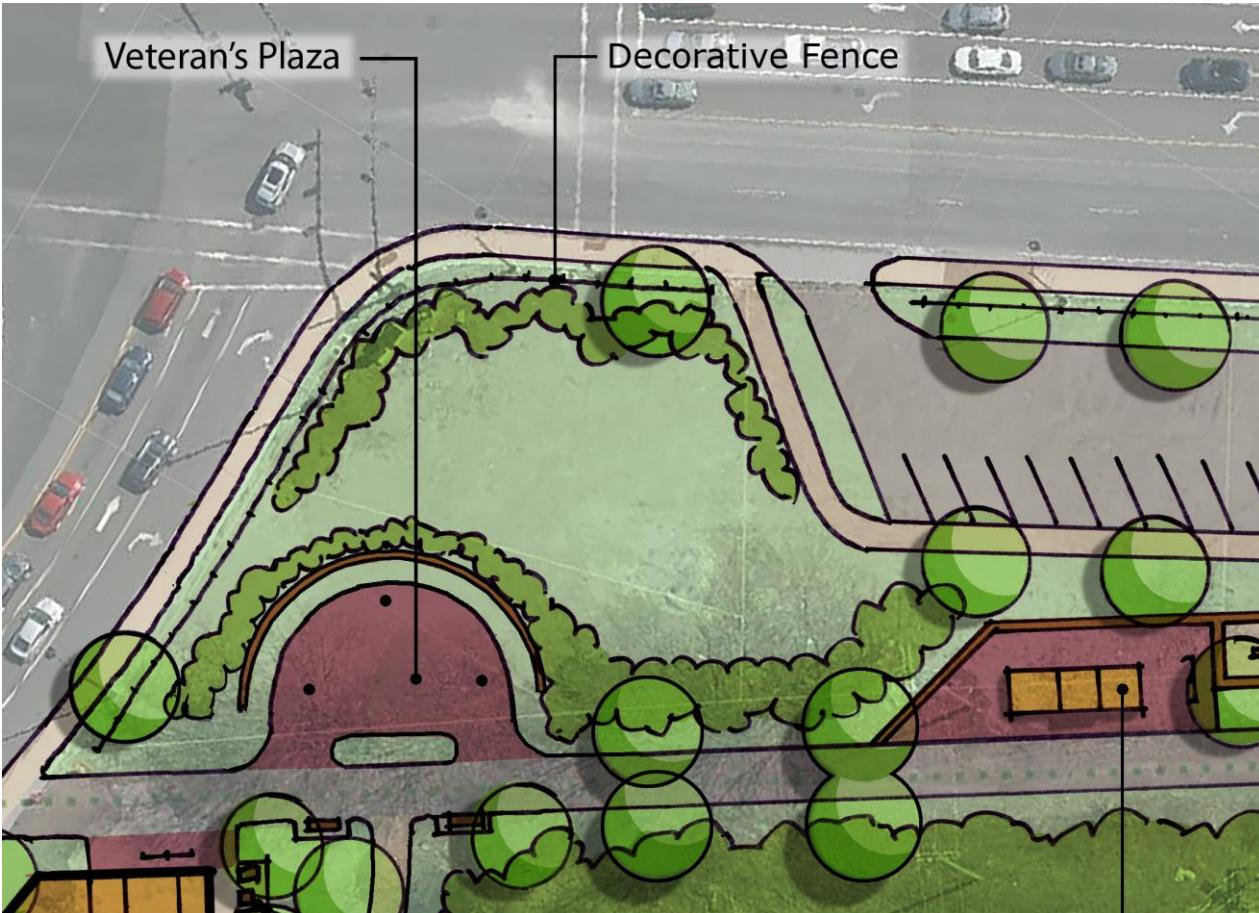
- Create accessible access to lawn from the Rail Trail
- Create gardens along Broadway and along property line to the north
- Locate a gazebo for small scale events
- Include a fountain
- Maintain unobstructed view to the existing Depot building from Broadway

# Gateway/Main Street Parcel



- Maintain existing parking
- Provide restrooms and water adjacent to the Rail Trail
- Consider providing a leased space to provide Rail Trail related services.
- Provide shared access to parking and Liberty substation
- Provide active recreation space with a playground and musical instruments
- Create a gateway to the Depot area on Main Street
- Do not compete visually with the Veteran's Plaza

# Veteran's Plaza



- Maintain/incorporate existing design for Veteran's Plaza
- Maintain unobstructed view from Broadway/Main Street intersection
- Provide continuous streetscape elements
- Use the foreground space for passive uses

# Broadway Frontage



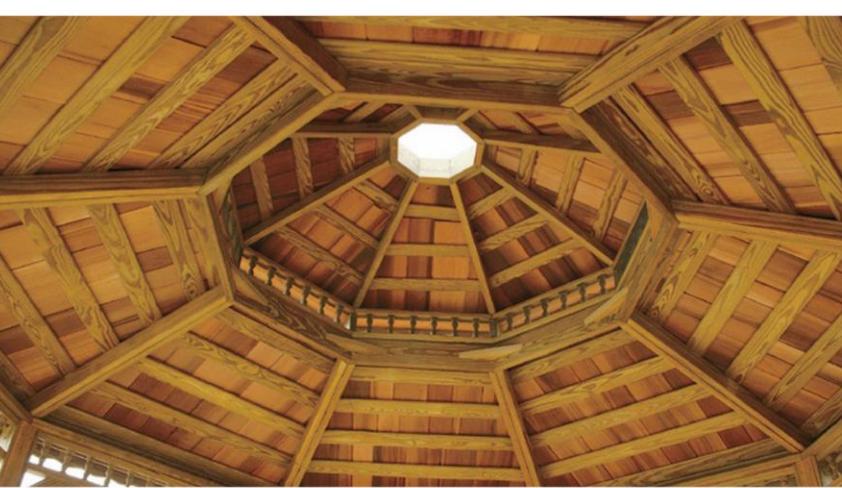
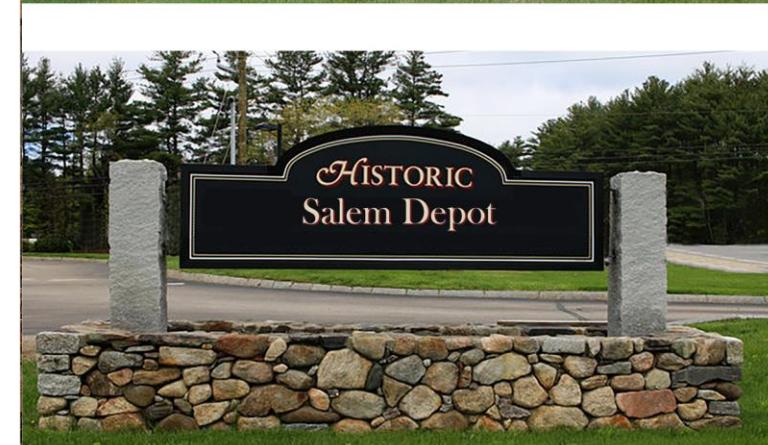
- Create additional parking utilizing the existing curb cuts on Broadway
- Create accessible route to the rail trail
- Locate an area for rail-themed interpretive displays – Renovated caboose or “depot” arcade
- Provide food truck area to activate the area
- Provide picnic area and recreation opportunities
- Plant screening vegetation between rail trail and existing residences
- Provide consistent streetscape and furnishings

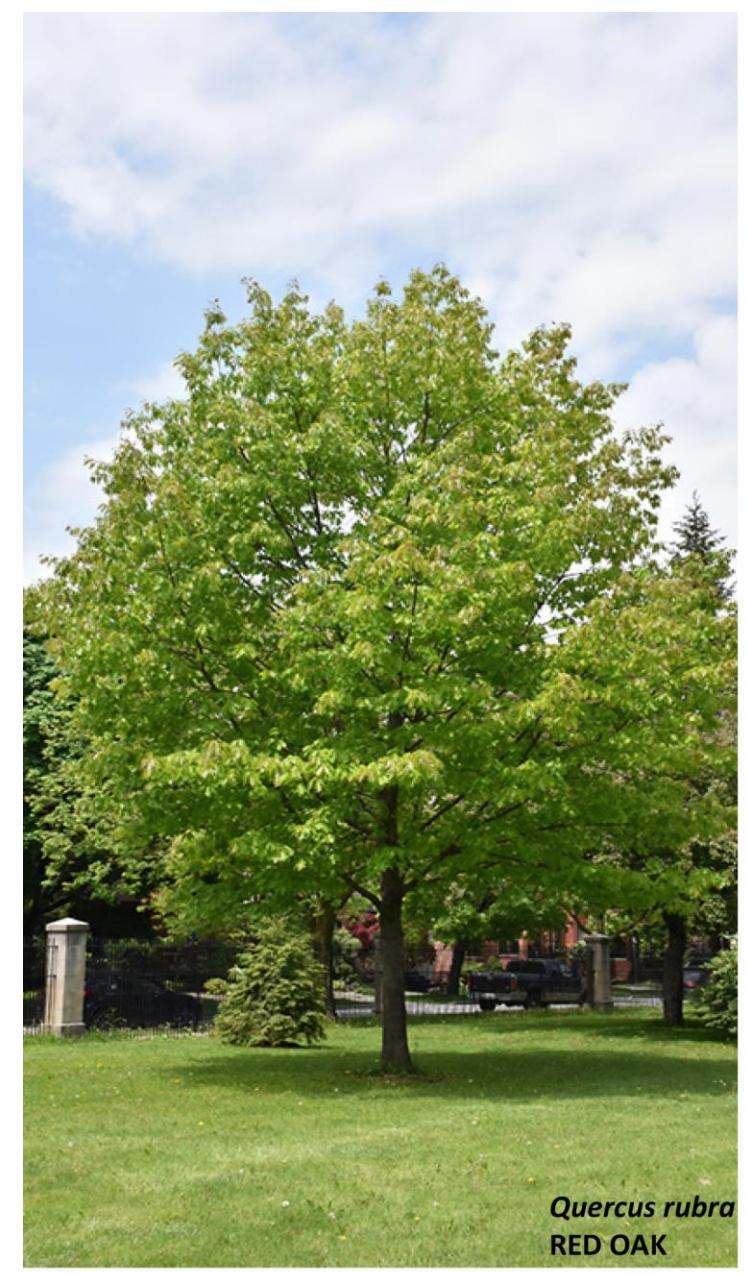

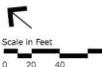
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# Project Phasing
